Monkey and Banana

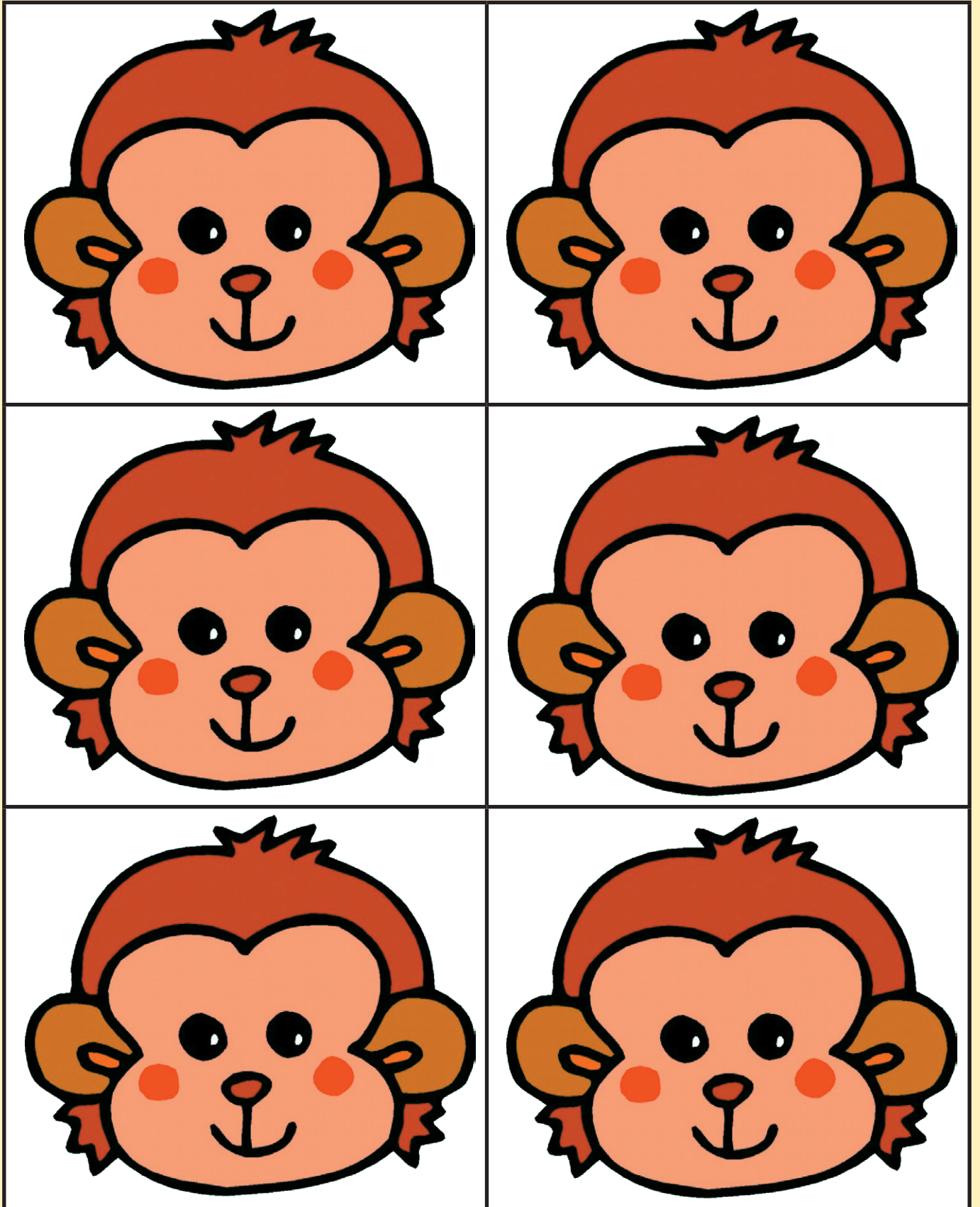


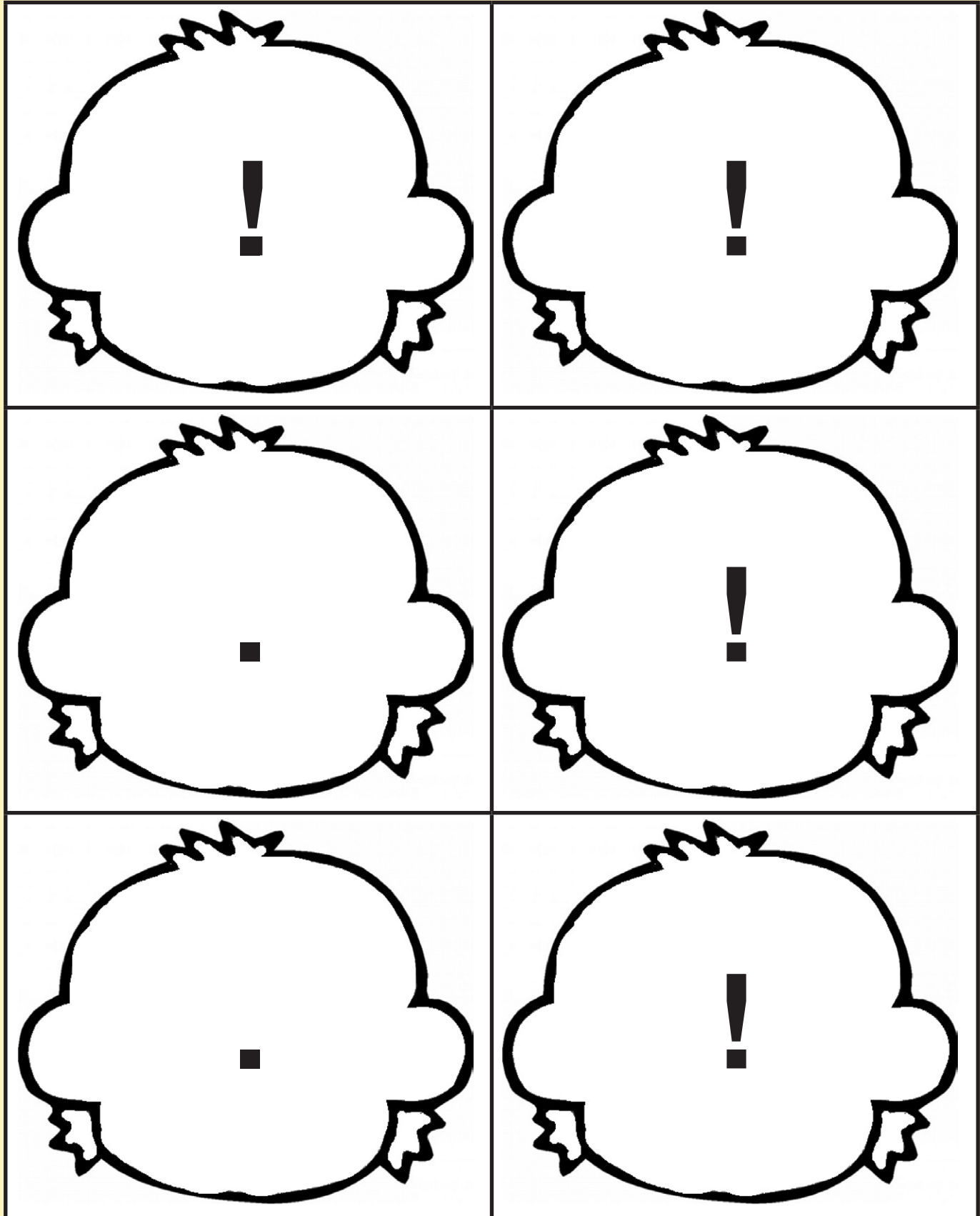
(Players 1–4)

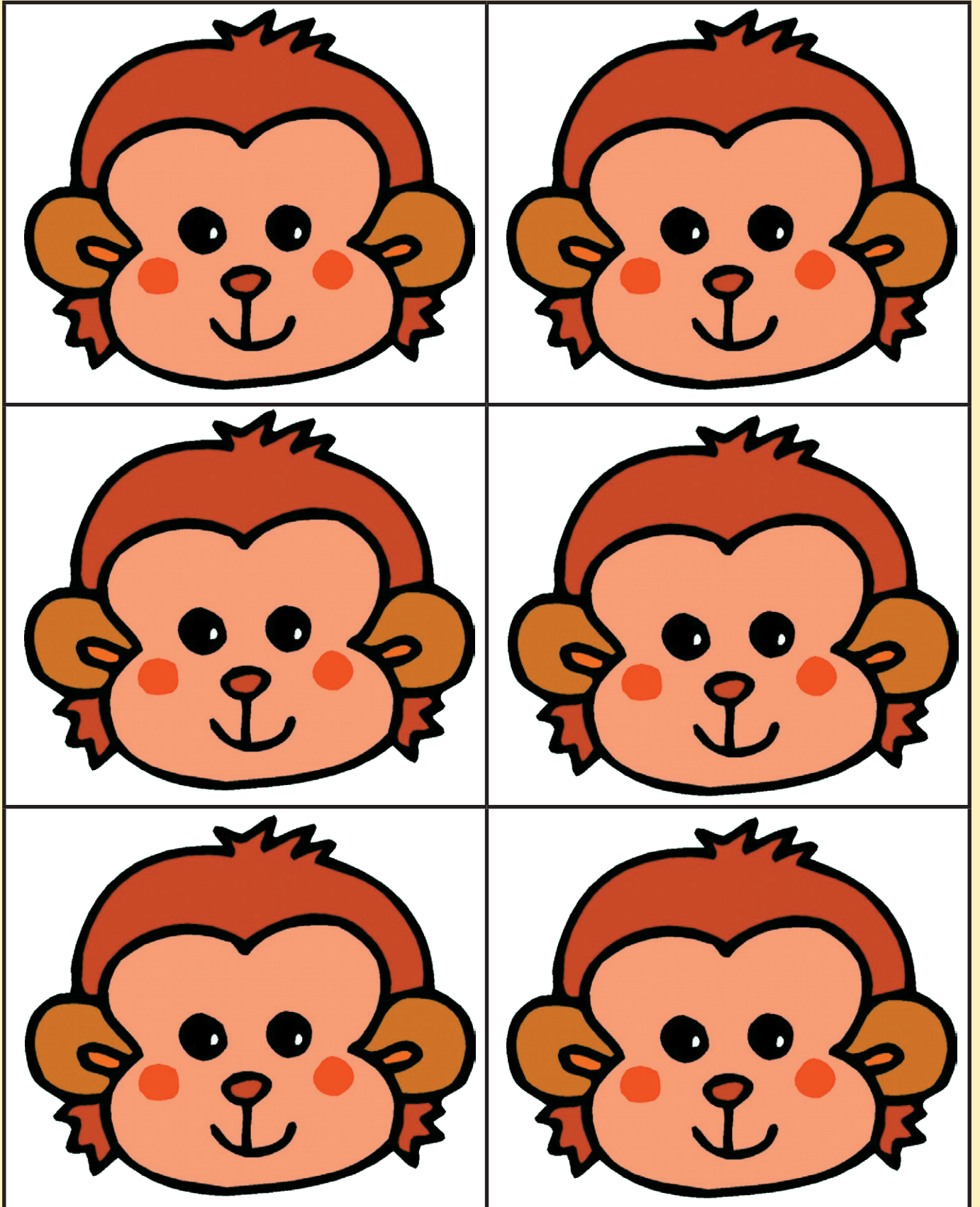
1. Place the monkey faces and bananas face down in middle of the group.

4. The player to match the most monkeys with punctuation to bananas with punctuation labels is the winner.

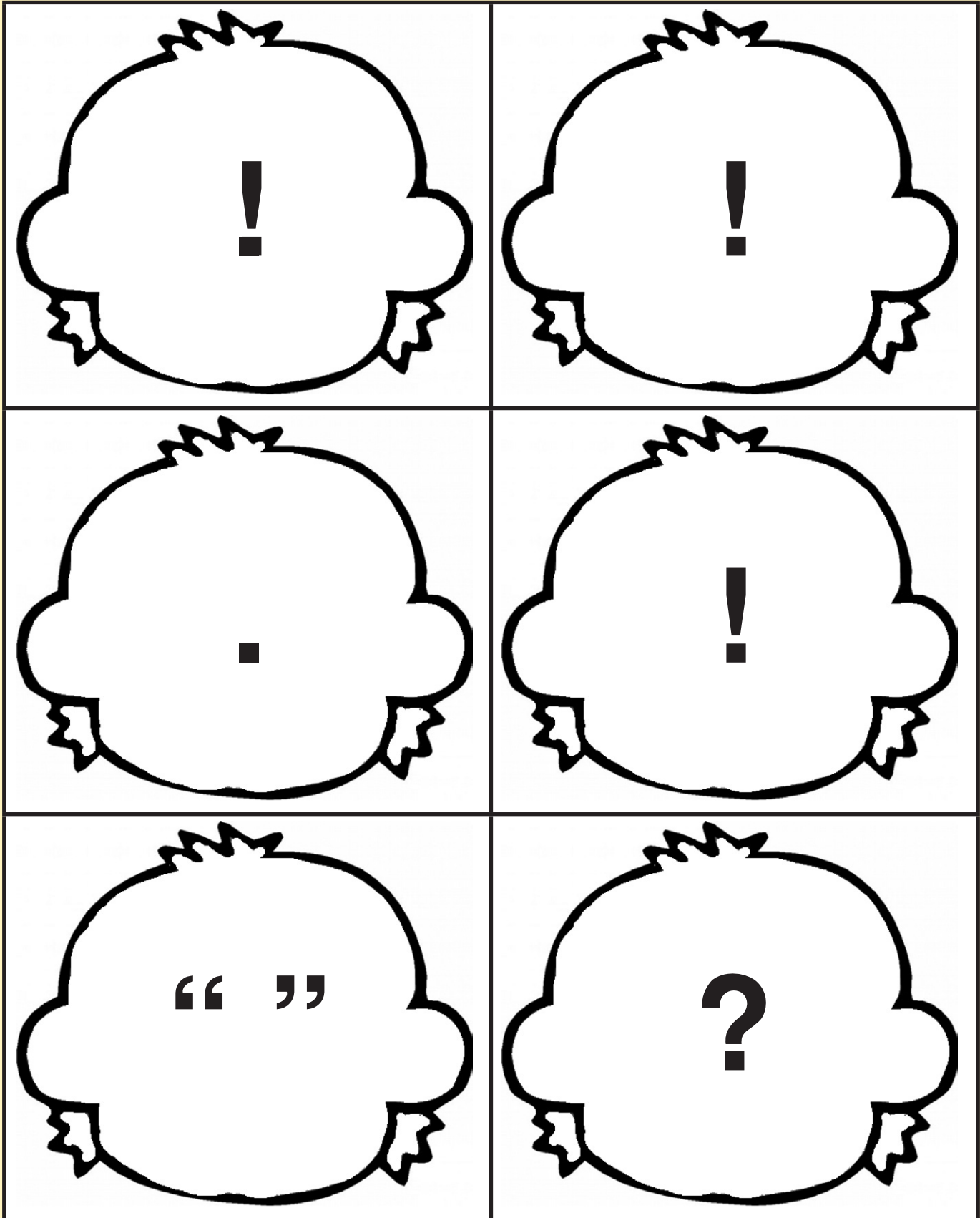
